Présent simple	Pronom personnel + Verbe conjugué Exemples : <u>I have</u> two brothers <u>he likes</u> music	- Actions habituelles, répétitives Exemple: Every day, I wake up at 6:00 am. Tous les jours, je me réveille à 6 heures. - Vérités générales Exemple: Water boils at 100°C. L'eau bout à 100°C.
Présent continu	Pronom personnel + Verbe 'be' conjugué + Verbe en -ing Exemples : I am doing the washing-up He is singing a song	- Actions ayant lieu au moment où l'on parle Exemple: What are you doing? I'm playing video games. Que fais-tu? Je joue à des jeux vidéo. Qu'est-ce que tu es en train de faire? Je suis en train de jouer à des jeux vidéo.
Present perfect simple	Pronom personnel + Have conjugué + participe passé du verbe Exemples : <u>I have worked</u> too much <u>He has done</u> so bad things	- Indique une relation entre un fait passé et le présent, c'est-à-dire un fait dans le passé mais ayant un résultat présent. Exemple: I have lost my keys. j'ai perdu mes clés. Explication: L'action de les perdre s'est produite dans le passé mais le résultat présent est que je ne les ai plus.
Present perfect continu	Pronom personnel + Have conjugué + been + verbe en -ing Exemples : I have been running throughout the town. He has been driving his car for 2 hours.	- Il a la même utilisation que le present perfect simple. Il sert à insister sur une durée. Exemple : I have been working for 7 hours. Je travaille depuis 7 heures. Remarque : On pourrait très bien dire « I have worked for 7 hours » mais la forme en -ing insiste davantage sur la durée de l'action.
Prétérit simple	Pronom personnel + Verbe conjugué au prétérit Exemples : <u>I went</u> to the cinema <u>He played</u> bowls	- Actions passées et terminées et datées sans rapport avec le présent Exemple: I found a banknote on the ground last week. La semaine dernière, j'ai trouvé un billet par terre. - Habitudes dans le passé Exemple: On Wednesdays, I played the piano with my grandmother Chaque mercredi, je jouais du piano avec ma grand-mère.
Prétérit continu	Pronom personnel + « be » conjugué au prétérit + Verbe en -ing Exemples : <u>He was doing</u> his job <u>They were playing</u> cards	 - Utilisé lorsqu'on parle d'une action en cours de déroulement dans le passé. Il traduit le « j'étais en train de » en français. Exemple: I was doing my homework. J'étais en train de faire mes devoirs. - Parler d'une action antérieure à une autre Exemple: I was helping my mother when you arrived J'étais en train d'aider ma mère quand tu es arrivé.

Le présent continu

Le présent continu (present continuous) est une action qui a lieu dans le moment présent, et qui n'est pas encore achevée.

→ II se conjugue ainsi : verbe TO BE + Gérondif (verbe+ing)

I	Am working	Am being	Am having	Am doing	Am going

Le Present Perfect Simple

Le Present Perfect simple est une action dans le long terme, qui a commencé dans le passé, mais qui continue toujours dans le présent. Le present perfect désigne aussi des actions qui ont commencé mais qui n'ont pas été terminées.

→ Conjugaison : have / has + participe passé

Le Present Perfect Continu

Le Present Perfect continu (present perfect continuous), est comme le présent perfect simple, mais on insiste davantage sur la durée. Il exprime une action longue qui n'est pas terminée.

→ Conjugaison : have / has + been + gérondif (verbe en -ing)

Le prétérit simple

Le prétérit simple (past simple) est une action qui est terminée, et qui n'a pas de lien avec le présent. C'est un temps souvent utilisé pour raconter une histoire.

- → Un verbe régulier se conjugue ainsi : verbe + ED
- → Pour les verbes irréguliers, se référer au tableau des verbes irréguliers.

Le prétérit continu

Le prétérit progressif (past continuous) est une action en cours qui s'est déroulée dans le passé. L'action se déroule avant un élément déclencheur qui se situe dans le passé.

→ Un verbe régulier se conjugue ainsi : was/were + gérondif (verbe en -ing)

The Past Perfect Simple

Le Past Perfect (aussi appelé "pluperfect") est une action dans le passé qui a un rapport avec une autre action dans le passé. Celle-ci a été terminée avant une autre action.

→ Conjugaison : had + participe passé

The Past Perfect Continuous

Le Past Perfect Continuous (aussi appelé "pluperfect" continu) est une action qui se déroulait dans le passé.

→ Conjugaison : had been + gerondif (verbe en -ing)

The Future

Le futur est une action qui se déroule à l'avenir, sans lien direct vers le présent.

→ Conjugaison : will + infinitif

I	Will work	Will be	Will have	Will do	Will go
You	Will work	Will be	Will have	Will do	Will go
He / She / It	Will work	Will be	Will have	Will do	Will go
